

# Christmas Bracelet

You will need:

1 x 260 red  
1 x 260 Blush  
1 x 160 White



Inflate the red 260 balloon leaving a 6" tip. Inflate the blush 260 to 3". Let the air out then re-inflate. Do this three times and then tie. \*\*



Tie the red balloon to the lip of the blush.



Make a 3" bubble and wrap the un-inflated blush in at the base of the bubble. This will be the head and back of the hood.



Make a small loop (about 3") in the red balloon under the head.



Make another small loop the same size.



Extend a red bubble over the top of the head and twist back in under the head.



Make a 3" bubble to represent the body.



Continue with two loops at least 4" for the skirt.



Bring the un-inflated blush balloon through the loop under the head, down through one of the skirt loops, up through the other skirt and back to the top loop.



Inflate the white 160 or 160 scrap to 6". Twist it into the base of the head and squeeze it down as you wrap it around the face so it isn't too full. Wrap it in under the head.



Now you can either remove the remaining white or you might want to being some small white bubbles down to the skirt as in the next pictures.



Draw a face and she is ready to wear.

\*\* Inflating the balloon and letting the air out a few times makes the bubble wider.
