

Duckling

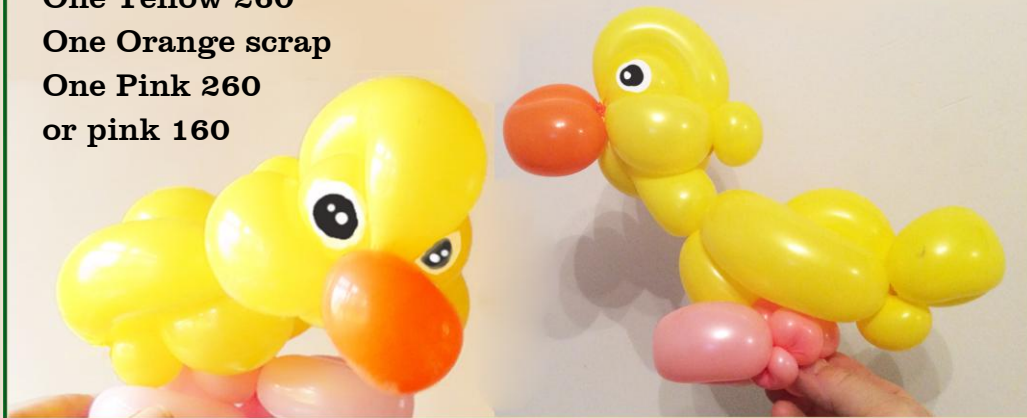
You will need

One Yellow 260

One Orange scrap

One Pink 260

or pink 160



Inflate the yellow 260 balloon leaving a 6" tip. Make a 1" bubble.



Holding the bubble in the middle and pulling the lip down, twist the bubble round.



Push the lip through the space under the pinched bubble.



This is what you should have.



Make a 2" bubble. This will be one of the cheeks.



Make two 1" bubble. These will be the eyes.



Twist the eyes together.



Beak - Inflate a 260 scrap to 3" and tie the ends together.



Tie the beak into the two lock-twisted eyes.



Make another 2" cheek. Twist it into the first pinched bubble.



The top of the head will be a 3" bubble.



Take the 3" bubble over the two eyes and wrap it into the beak.



Give the balloon a squeeze and ease it back between the two cheek bubbles.



This is how it should look.



Make a 1" bubble. This is the neck.



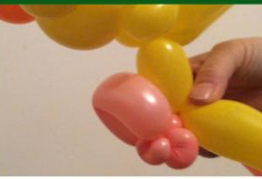
Make two 3½-4" bubbles for the body. Smaller is cuter. Lock twist then together.



Inflate a pink 160 balloon to about 12". Make two small pinch twists and one 4" loop.



Make a ½" bubble.



Going back to the yellow duck, make a 2" bubble and wrap the pink ½" bubble in.



Make another ½" pink bubble followed by two small pinched bubbles.



Make a 4" loop for the second foot.



Make a 1" bubble in the yellow balloon.



Make another 1" bubble and ease it up between the two body bubbles.



Finish with a loop for the tail and a pinched 1" bubble. This will sit under the tail.
